The Derwent Drug Registry is designed to be used in conjunction with the companion bibliographic file. It provides a reference to all established drugs and chemicals indexed in the Derwent Drug File. It provides the capability for retrieving groups of drugs that have common structural features and/or biological activities. The Registry covers the full name of drugs, activities, chemical molecular formulas and synonyms. Updated semiannually.
